

Aracode Population, Caste, Working Data

The Nilgiris, Tamil Nadu - Census 2011

Aracode is a village situated in Kotagiri taluka of The Nilgiris district in Tamil Nadu. As per the Population Census 2011, there are total 189 families residing in the village Aracode. The **total population of Aracode is 781** out of which 386 are males and 395 are females thus the **Average Sex Ratio of Aracode is 1,023**.

The population of Children of age 0-6 years in Aracode village is 110 which is 14% of the total population. There are 50 male children and 60 female children between the age 0-6 years. Thus as per the Census 2011 the **Child Sex Ratio of Aracode is 1,200** which is greater than Average Sex Ratio (1,023) of Aracode village.

As per the Census 2011, the **literacy rate of Aracode is 72.13%**. Thus Aracode village has lower literacy rate compared to 77.5% of The Nilgiris district. The male literacy rate is 80.36% and the female literacy rate is 63.88% in Aracode village.

Schedule Caste (SC) constitutes 0.3% while Schedule Tribe (ST) were 98.8% of total population in Aracode village.

Working Population as per Census 2011

In Aracode village out of total population, 432 were engaged in work activities. 84.3% of workers describe their work as Main Work (Employment or Earning more than 6 Months) while 15.7% were involved in Marginal activity providing livelihood for less than 6 months. Of 432 workers engaged in Main Work, 0 were cultivators (owner or co-owner) while 0 were Agricultural labourer.
