Kengarai Population, Caste, Working Data The Nilgiris, Tamil Nadu - Census 2011

Kengarai is a village situated in Kotagiri taluka of The Nilgiris district in Tamil Nadu. As per the Population Census 2011, there are total 1,971 families residing in the village Kengarai. The **total population of Kengarai is 6,820** out of which 3,348 are males and 3,472 are females thus the **Average Sex Ratio of Kengarai is 1,037**.

The population of Children of age 0-6 years in Kengarai village is 526 which is 8% of the total population. There are 295 male children and 231 female children between the age 0-6 years. Thus as per the Census 2011 the **Child Sex Ratio of Kengarai is 783** which is less than Average Sex Ratio (1,037) of Kengarai village.

As per the Census 2011, the **literacy rate of Kengarai is 80.9%**. Thus Kengarai village has higher literacy rate compared to 77.5% of The Nilgiris district. The male literacy rate is 92.04% and the female literacy rate is 70.35% in Kengarai village.
