Denad is a village situated in Kotagiri taluka of The Nilgiris district in Tamil Nadu. As per the Population Census 2011, there are total 2,309 families residing in the village Denad. The **total population of Denad is 8,284** out of which 4,061 are males and 4,223 are females thus the **Average Sex Ratio of Denad is 1,040**.

The population of Children of age 0-6 years in Denad village is 680 which is 8% of the total population. There are 344 male children and 336 female children between the age 0-6 years. Thus as per the Census 2011 the **Child Sex Ratio of Denad is 977** which is less than Average Sex Ratio (1,040) of Denad village.

As per the Census 2011, the **literacy rate of Denad is 83.4%**. Thus Denad village has higher literacy rate compared to 77.5% of The Nilgiris district. The male literacy rate is 91.69% and the female literacy rate is 75.38% in Denad village.
