

Honey bees of the Apis family and stingless bees are the main sources of natural honey. Bees make honey for specific reasons and in so doing they also help to pollinate forest and agriculture crops. The *adivasi* or indigenous peoples have an innate knowledge about bees and their ecology. A knowledge which helps them take honey, trade with it, sustain the bees and the forests. Their understanding of the ecosystem also tells the the story honey bee diversity and local and culturally rooted ways nurturing bees.
